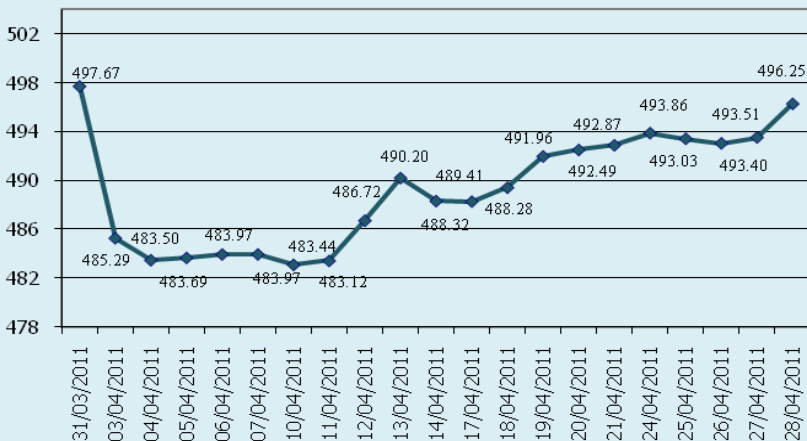


Al-Quds Index

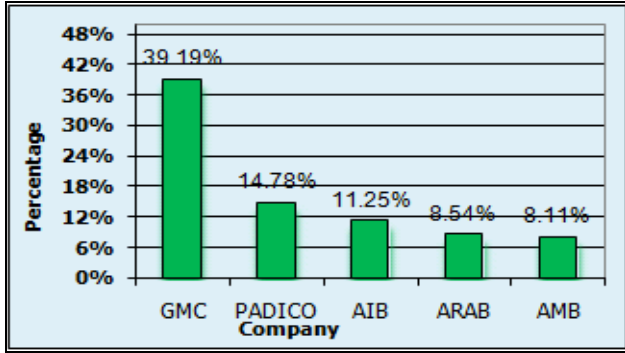
**Daily close of AL- Quds Index

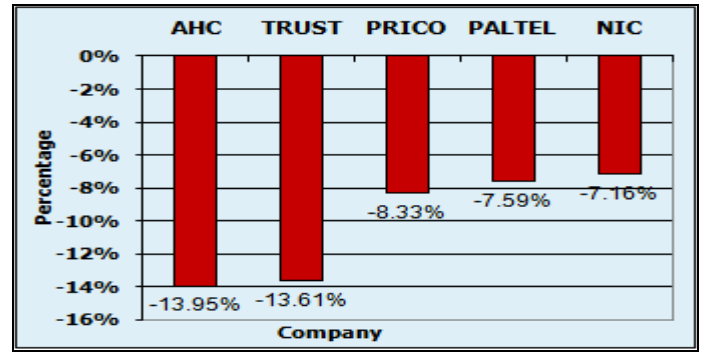

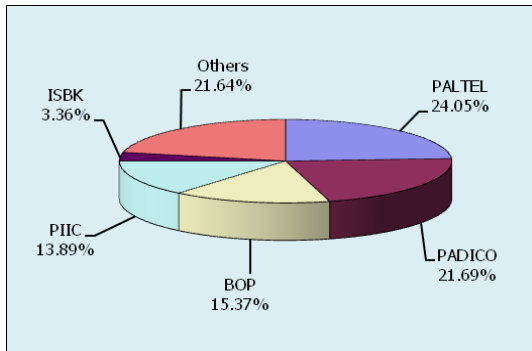

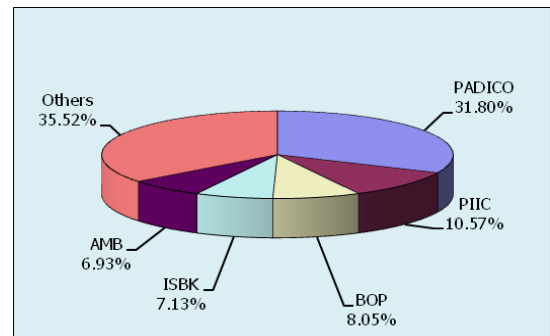
